It gives me great happiness to approach you all and introduce myself to all of you through this wonderful God given ministry to Vishwa Vani.

I am Dr. Prabhavathi born in this world on 21.10.1971 in a Hindu family but became a born again Christian in April 2000. By profession I am a Doctor. I did my MBBS.M.D. D.N.B in Obstetrics and Gynecology. Right now I am practicing as a gynecologist in Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh, India. In one sentence I can say what I am is all because of our loving gracious God.

In the initial days when I was introduced to Vishwa Vani ministry I lifted my hand up to adopt one village. That time I was working at Ambajipeta mission hospital. Later I had a burden to adopt 2 villages and did so but I was not regular in offering my tithes to church ministry as I was not able to adjust the financial status at home. That guilt was there in my heart and was pricking me. Later I had to shift to Kakinada. But when I came here the situation was worse. I was a beginner in Private Practice here with very few patients per day. All the finance was handled by my husband. Nothing in my hand except my heart for Lord's ministry. From hospital I went back to my room and closed the doors, opened my heart in front of the Lord. Tears just flowed down started praying "O Lord if I am not able to be used for your ministry I don't want to stay in this world. I had a gold ring which was presented to me. I sold it and it was sufficient for that month." employment. So I was able to do next 3 months. Again like a small child looking at father for her pocket money all the time she finishes, I again sought fathers (God's) advice. There was a leading for me to go and ask my husband. As the OP (Out Patient Consultation) was less (it was only few months I started) he said very firmly you can take money from OP bills but not from inpatient bills. God blessed the Out patient department. I could help the ministry comfortably. Then I asked God to help me to be regular in giving tithe to the church. God fulfilled my desire. One day I came to know that Bro. Emil Jeba Singh keeps his hand on the India map and pray for the unreached villages and that's how God gives them villages one by one. I felt very happy when I heard that. I too started asking God to give me one more village. God helped me to do so. During building expansion of the hospital we use to face difficult financial crises. In such situations I used to lift up my hand for the adoption of the new villages. At one point I was able to adopt 7 villages. On one of my birthday's, I knew it was beyond my capacity but I also knew very well that God can make it possible. Hence I asked Him for 5 more villages to be adopted. He did it. Praise for all the 12 villages that I support now. But when I heard the need I felt it is just like a drop in the ocean.

I happened to attend one of the Vishwa Vani meeting conducted in a village where I saw the whole statistics. I saw the crowd. It was more than 1500. But when there was a calling only one village was adopted. I praised God for it. But started praying and thinking how to reach the goal of 100,000 villages by 2015. I felt God wants everyone to pray. He wants every one to work and he wants everyone to be saved. The thought of sowing and reaping came into my mind. I remembered this saying.

We are all saved to save others. Then I felt every person right from childhood to adulthood & retired life should be involved. I felt if every believer can cultivate and earn at least Rs. 5 per month. We can reach all the unreached. First I started to see how practical it is. We planted green leafy vegetables. We got the first crop in 1½ months. We all were excited when we saw our 1st crop. It was so fresh. So.....much. We praise God; we sold it to our fellow believers. They all enjoyed and rejoiced. We thought one person at least Rs.5 per month but in practical it was more than 500. It was a very small garden. Just few yards of land. When we were sowing and reaping and also when the plants were growing we learnt many spiritual lessons. I introduced it to my family members too, right to my children, to our house maid to parents and relatives. My daughter improved in her science knowledge. She was blessed by God as she was doing it for God. She stood first in all 4 sections and in her thanksgiving prayer 8 souls were saved.

Later our few yards of garden in down stairs we made it a fruit garden and we shifted our plant garden to terrace. It yielded more. I have planted green leafy vegetables like Palak (spinach), methi (Fenugreek), vegetables and lady's finger, beans chilies, beetle guard etc.,

It was very tasty and very healthy. Very recently we planted maize. We were so surprised to see maize plant on the front cover of Vishwa Vani monthly magazine in month of April 2009. Except God and us none knew

about our maize plant. When I saw that I felt God wants me to write. Genesis 50:22 came to my thought.

There were many people who helped me in doing this work. Our dear brother Krishna, Vishwa Vani staff and his wife Lakshmi were of great help & are a back bone of prayer. We informed the management of Vishwa Vani. They have utilized this money for a school campus which they are planning shortly in the tribal area. How great thou art.

Final Note:

This is the way every person in the house has to do.

1. Pray and prepare your heart to do this work.
2. Commit your self to God.
3. Search a place either down or on terrace, or in any school if you have place in your school or in any place which is being wasted and which is within your reach.
4. Don't waste any empty land.
5. When you reap, but for yourself and sell it your friends neighbors exactly to the same value as it is outside. Never take extra.
6. This amount you utilize it to adopt a new village.

7. Next target is 10,000 villages for Andhra Pradesh.
8. All the field workers, when they visit house and spread the Good News. While you are returning back. Plant some seeds, or any tree – banana, papaya etc. (at least one).
 - Every day they see the plant they will remember the God's words. If possible you can write a verse on a wood and put it next to the plant.
 - Make sure you cover all the houses in your village.
 - There should not be a single house without a Vishwa Vani plant.

Gospel has to be preached to all the unreached villages.
